Following are the highlights of the Triennial Conference:

1. The Auditorium of Vivekananda Vidya Mandir was tastefully decorated with flowers and banners containing different demands of the Retirees. The senior citizens with the zeal and enthusiasm of the youth stood in two rows at the entrance and shouted slogans to greet the leaders.

2. The house was full with a compact audience of more than **200** persons. The Presidium comprised of the following persons:

A) **Com. L.N. Giri** – Sr. Vice President, B) **Com. Debasis Sengupta** – Secretary, C) **Com. S.K. Mazumdar** -Jt. Secretary, D) **Com. Hemant Kumar** - Chairman, Reception Committee and E) **Com. Primus Tirkey** – Treasurer. The Central leadership of AIBPARC was represented by **Com. Suprita Sarkar** – General Secretary. **Com. N.K. Sahi** anchored the inaugural session.

3. All the initial formalities being over, **Com. Debasis Sengupta**, Secretary of the outgoing committee placed an exhaustive written report and **Com. Tirkey**, the Treasurer placed the Accounts. Apart from the report and the accounts, resolutions were also placed for the consideration of the house. It was really heartening to see that a good number of participants took part in deliberations and after hearing the reply of the Secretary, all the papers submitted before the house were passed unanimously.



4. **Com. Suprita Sarkar** in his hour-long address informed in details the conversations which the leaders of CBPRO/AIBPARC had with the Secretary, DFS, MOF, GOI on different issues pertaining to updation of pension in a package. The organization, he reported, had a feeling and impression that the officials have understood the crux of the issue and it was hoped that favourable decisions would follow but the unfortunate situation is that the pension updation is still an unresolved issue. He also explained in details the present status of the M.C. Singla case pending before the Supreme Court and the GST exemption case pending before the Kerala High Court. **He urged upon the members to stand solidly by the side of the organization so that the year of 2026 can be turned into a year of achievement.**

5. The elections of the organization took place in a hassle-free manner. The house unanimously elected **Com. R.K. Sinha** (AIPNBPA) as the President and **Com. D. Sengupta** (BOIPARA) as the Secretary along with different other office bearers for various posts. We congratulate the entire leadership and do expect that the very successful holding of the 5<sup>th</sup> Triennial Conference would further strengthen the movement of Retirees in this part of the country.
