- 4) Shri Hirak Kumar Sarkar, Chairman, Reception Committee and Shri P.K. Malhotra, GS, AIPNBPRA welcomed all Delegates, Guests, Observers and Dignitaries. The greetings received from Cm. K.V. Acharya, President, AIBPARC, Com. G.D. Nadaf, Advisor, AIBPARC and various other executives of the Bank were read out before the audience. As a part of social awareness programme, the organisation distributed mosquito nets to 100 needy persons. The venture was praised by all present.
- 5) Different speakers, mainly representing the serving organisations of Bank employees and officers, the organisation of Retirees and Executives representing Bank Management discussed various issues affecting the interest of the Retirees. It was a scholastic session from which the audience could gather enough inputs to understand where the situation exactly lies. The leaders of AIBPARC made it clear that the organisation would leave no stone unturned to achieve the much desired goals. A strong message was given against privatization and a deep solidarity between the communities of retirees and the serving people was aimed at. Similarly, the leaders of the serving organisations pledged total support to the cause of the elder citizens of the industry.
- 6) A grand programme was organized to celebrate the integration of two affiliates of AIBPARC in PNB and in erstwhile UBI. The unification of the two organisations having a total strength of more 8000 Retirees was celebrated by thunderous applause, clapping, beating of drums and cutting of cakes, etc. "Our Unity Zindabad" was the main slogan and the principal theme of the occasion. The memorandum of understanding signed by the top leadership of both the organisations was exchanged.
- 7) In the Business Session, the Report of the General Secretary, audited accounts and different resolutions were presented before the house for discussion and adoption. Members supported the placements in a big way. Shri Tapas Basu, the Returning Officer declared the results of the elections of the office bearers of AIPNBPRA for the term 2022-25. Shri P.K. Malhotra and Shri Asok Kumar Dey have been elected unanimously as President and General Secretary of the organisation. Shri Suprita Sarkar has been elected as the Chairman. The affiliate has already issued an elaborate circular stating inter-alia the names of all the office bearers elected in different posts. We congratulate each one of them. The meeting ended with the vote of thanks proposed by Com. R.Narayanan.

Comrades, braving highly inclement weather and different other adverse situations, large number of volunteers, activists and leaders worked day in and day out to make the conference an astounding success. It will continue to remain one of the landmarks in the history of AIPNBPRA as it witnessed a most hassle-free unification of two existing affiliates of AIBPARC.
