Dear Comrade,

Sub: Our affiliate at E-Syndicate Bank, CBSPRA, organized its 5th Triennial Central Conference & General Body meeting on 22nd February, 2026 at Hyderabad in the midst of massive participation and remarkable enthusiasm.

1. We like to convey to all concerned that it was an extraordinary conference in as much as the Assembly assumed historic proportion because it celebrated the centenary of Syndicate Bank. A huge attendance of more than one thousand delegates and observers from different parts of the country of various age groups thronged together to have a feeling of oneness. It was a good remembrance of the history of the Banks as well as the organization.

2. The venue, Visvesvaraya Bhavan, Institution of Engineers (India), Khairatabad, Hyderabad, was tastefully decorated by thematic banners, flags and festoons. On the dais, there had been the portraits of the founders of both Canara Bank & Syndicate Bank. The leaders of CBSPRA, AIBPARC and CBPRO were greeted with thunderous slogans.

3. The leaders of the movement who remained present on the dais include: **Com. K. V. Acharya, President of AIBPARC and Joint Convenor of CBPRO; Com. G. D. Nadaf, General Secretary, FSBIPA and Joint Convenor, CBPRO; Com. Suprita Sarkar, General Secretary, AIBPARC; Com. S. Kuppuswami (Ind Bk) and Com. A. N. Krishna Murthy (Canara), Both Working Presidents, AIBPARC; Com. S.A. Manjrekar, and Com HV Coelho, Former General Secretary, and President SBOA; Com. Bennet Sebastian, General Secretary, CBOF and Com. Chakrapani (SBH), President, Com. Madhusudan (CBI), Secretary, AIBPARC AP/Telangana State Unit. They were joined by our own leaders, namely Com. C. Gangadhar Yadav, Chairman, CBSPRA and Working President, AIBPARC; Com. R. K. Sharma, President; Com. Prakash Karotya and Com. A. Venkatesan, Working Presidents; Com. D. Rakshit, Former President, CBSPRA. They were welcomed by Reception Committee Chairman Com V Krishna**

Kumar, Zonal Secretary Hyderabad Zone. He explained the arrangements made for the comfortable stay of the delegates and leaders, logistics and hospitality at the conference venue. The conference was presided over by Com. C. Gangadhar Yadav, Chairman, CBSPRA.

4. The proceedings followed in the normal course of business – lighting of the lamp, the invocation, the offering floral tributes to the founders of Canara Bank & Syndicate Bank, welcoming the guests of the dais by flower



bouquet and Uttariya and delivery of welcome address by **Com. C. Gangadhar Yadav**, the Chairman of the organization. He mentioned the contribution of each leader on the dais in the movement of Retirees and observed that the holding of the Triennial Conference was not merely a statutory responsibility of the organization but also it offered a good opportunity to assess its own duties and responsibilities towards the membership, the Bank and the Nation. He also made a mention of the unfortunate absence of **Com. K. Sureshbabu**, General Secretary, who had a fall causing fracture in the femur. **Com. R.K. Sharma, President of the organization** informed the house that the membership of the organization crossed 16,600 and hoped that by the next Triennial Conference, the figures would cross 20,000.

5. * Com. K.V. Acharya, President, AIBPARC & Joint Convenor, CBPRO traced the relentless efforts of AIBPARC since its inception to achieve Pension Updation and other very important demands affecting the interest of the Pensioners & Retirees. He informed in detail the present positions of the M.C. Singla case pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and cautioned members against being carried away by speculative interpretations in the social media. He also observed that the IBA is continuously shifting its stands in the face of Judicial scrutiny and making wrong interpretations of Regulation 35(1). He assured the house that AIBPARC is seized with the responsibility which the membership has conferred upon the organization.

*** Com. G.D. Nadaf, Advisor, AIBPARC & Joint Convenor, CBPRO** appreciated the thoughtful display of the portraits of the founders of the Banks symbolizing the continuity of legacy and values. He demanded that the pension updation must be implemented in accordance with the Regulation 35(1). When it has already been implemented in RBI, he asked, why then there is a hesitation on the part of GOI/IBA. He demanded an early implementation.

*** Com. Suprita Sarkar, General Secretary, AIBPARC**, narrated how the organization has been tirelessly working to push the agenda item through the bureaucracy by having regular dialogue with the DFS, MOF, GOI, by knocking the doors of the judiciary and also hitting the streets whenever necessary. He expressed optimism that the year of 2026 will be a year of achievement.

* All other speakers present on the dais greeted the conference and wished that the organization will prosper further in days to come. **Com. M.S. Prakash Rao, Treasurer, CBSPRA** proposed vote of thanks for the inaugural session.

6. Business session:

* The written report of the General Secretary of CBSPRA, the financial statements for last 3 years, the amendments to the Regulation, the Resolutions and other papers were submitted before the house for its consideration. All the papers submitted before the house had been accepted unanimously. The business session was disciplined and orderly.

*** Elections:**

The team of office bearers was elected unanimously. Com. C. Gangadhar Yadav has been the Chairman; Com. R.K. Sharma has been the President and Com. V. Krishna Kumar has been elected as the General Secretary of the organization along with other office bearers.

7. Conclusion:

We congratulate all the leaders, activists, veterans and members for holding such a Triennial conference on a massive scale with so much of success. We believe that the huge assembly of the Retirees in the city will further strengthen the movement of the senior citizens in this part of the country. We convey our good wishes to all the newly elected office bearers and we do hope that the organization will move from strength to further strength in days to come.
