You are aware of the fact that a National Convention of Workers was held under the banner of joint platform of the Central Trade Unions of the country along with independent National Federation of all the sectors and service establishments on 26th May, 2015. The convention decided to hold All India General Strike on 2nd September, 2015 on its 12 Charter of Demand which include, inter-alia, the principal issues with which the working class of the country are confronted with.

Our organisation (AIBPARC) expresses its oneness and solidarity with the working class of the country and expresses its whole hearted support towards it. Our leaders, members, activists and veterans may attend the rallies and demonstrations organised in favour of such action programme.

We are happy to inform our members that the General Secretary of AIBOC has written another letter on 18th August, 2015 to the Chairman/CEO of IBA demanding calling of a meeting to discuss several agenda items which include, inter-alia, the issues of pensioners and retirees. The relevant portion of the letter is being quoted for information of members. He has "demanded a discussion with points covered in the Record Note on the issues of Bank retirees signed on the day of signing of Joint Note dated 25.5.2015 need to be initiated." He has also referred to AIBOC's earlier letter no. AIBOC/2015/68A dt. 12.06.2015 and 2015/86 dated 05.08.2015.
