**Sub: Meeting of the Senior Office Bearers with the Chairmen (where applicable), Presidents and General Secretaries of our affiliates held at Bengaluru on 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2026 to review the preparation/ arrangements of the 5<sup>th</sup> Triennial General Body Conference to be held at Ernakulam and take important decisions pertaining to the issues which are to be placed in the General Body.**

1. We have pleasure to convey that the meeting has effectively transacted all the agenda items mentioned in the notice dated 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2026. The participation of leaders had been precise and purposeful and several decisions have been arrived at.

2. **At the outset, Com. B. Sreekumar, State Secretary, AIBPARC, Kerala** briefed the House about the arrangements done so far. He covered issues like the capacity of the hall, the probable number of Retirees from Ernakulam and the adjoining districts who might attend the inaugural session, catering arrangements for those participating the Conference, arrangements for publicity and other relevant informations. **Com Paul Mundadan, General Secretary, Federal Bank Retired Officers Forum** also supplemented Com. Sreekumar's reporting. The meeting expressed satisfaction and advised them to take care of a few other issues.

3. The admissible number of Delegates and Observers for each affiliate in regard to the 5<sup>th</sup> Triennial General Body was determined and conveyed to the leadership of the respective organizations. A comprehensive list showing Affiliate-wise position of Delegates and Observers has been handed over to the Secretary of the host state unit.

4. The House unanimously agreed that a sum of Rs. **1500/-** (Rs. One thousand five hundred only) per Delegate/ Observer will be remitted by each Affiliate to the parent body at an early date to the following account:

5. The 22 nos of draft Resolutions placed by the General Secretary were discussed threadbare. Several members offered different suggestions to adopt a few more Resolutions and some members sent emails suggesting re-framing of the Resolutions. All such suggestions will be examined with care and the General Secretary will furnish the final resolutions in the last meeting of the Governing Council before the holding of the 5<sup>th</sup> Triennial conference.

6. Lot of discussion took place on the issue of the amendment to the Rules and the Regulations of the society. **It may please be noted that the following proposals, if accepted in the 5<sup>th</sup> GB, will be in force from the future date of the Conference. The decisions are:**

**A) Each affiliate will be eligible to get one Delegate per hundred members (which was earlier 200 members) subject to a maximum of 40 (enhanced from the existing number of 30) and a minimum of 5 (enhanced from the existing number of 2). If the broken number of membership after completion of full 100 crosses 50, then the affiliate will be eligible for additional 1 number of Delegate. Each affiliate will also be eligible to get Observers to the extent of 50% of the total number of Delegates.**

**B) As regards the number of posts in different segments, it has been decided that marginal increase and changes might be done in certain posts to create vacancies for accommodation of probable new affiliates, affiliates with higher membership which did not get representation in a proportionate manner in the existing list, Organisational requirements and also to ensure sectoral representation**

**C) All such proposals will be placed in a final shape in the last meeting of the present Governing council, which will be held just before the ensuing Conference, for its approval for the purpose of placement in the 5<sup>th</sup> Triennial General Body Conference as per direction given in Regulation number 16.1 of the Rules of the organization.**

7. When the discussion on the listed agenda items concluded, the President briefed the house on the Court cases pending before the Supreme Court (Pension Updation) and the Kerala High Court (Exemption of GST). The Working Presidents also addressed the House and offered valuable counselling to the General Secretary as regards adoption of certain more number of Resolutions on specified contemporary issues.

**We convey our sincerest thanks to the President and Secretary, AIBPARC, Karnataka State Committee, Com M R Gopinatha Rao and Com. A.N. Krishnamurthy and Team Karnataka for organizing the meeting with perfection and precision.**

**Comrades, Let us march on to Ernakulam to make the 5<sup>th</sup> Triennial and General Body Conference a historic success.**
