SPLENDID DISPLAY OF OUR UNITY & SOLIDARITY MASSIVE NATIONAL DHARNA AT JANTAR MANTAR-DELHI

We refer to our earlier circular enjoining upon our members, affiliates and constituents to participate in our National Dharna at Jantar Mantar on 07.01.2019. Our Delhi Units of CBPRO & AIBRF under the vibrant leadership of Com. D K Hans(CBPRO) & Com A K Bansal(AIBRF) had made elaborate arrangement for successful conduct of Massive National Dharna. Belying the apprehension in some quarters, about the severe winter 's impact on the number of participants, our Comrades thronged the venue right from 10.00 am onwards and the number kept swelling to eventually cross 5000 participants. It was a splendid display of the Unity & Solidarity by Bank Pensioners & Retirees. Seeing the magnitude of the gathering of the Bank Pensioners & Retirees, the authorities did not permit us to march to Parliament . However our senior leaders were escorted by the assigned Police Officials to submit a Joint Memorandum to The Secretary, Dept of Financial Services, Ministry of Finance, Govt of India, New Delhi. Our Dharna was a grand success with the following highlights:

1. Senior leaders of Bank Pensioners & Retirees movement like Com. P K Pathak (General Secretary SBI Pensioners Associations, Delhi circle), A Ramesh Babu & K V Acharya(Joint Convenors, CBPRO), S C Jain (General Secretary,AIBRF), Suprita Sarkar(General Secretary, AIBPARC), D D Maheshwari (Deputy General Secretary, RBONC), R L Rao(President,AIRBEA), T N Goel(President SBI Pensioners Association, Delhi Circle), J P Sharma(Vice President, AIBEA), A K Nagar (President AIBPARC, Delhi), Niranjana Mishra(Vice President, AIBRF), R K Sharma(Chairman AIBPARC-Delhi), Dr J D Sharma(Senior Vice President, AIBPARC-Delhi), D P Gupta (Vice President AIBRF), and Suresh Sharma (Organising Secretary, AIBRF) participated in the Dharna.

They called for resolution of all these issues by IBA and Government urgently. They also solicited support of UFBU in helping resolution of these issues along with impending wage revision settlement. The leaders also emphasized the need of providing a structured mechanism to the Bank Pensioners & Retirees for negotiating their pending issues and redressal of grievances on a regular basis. Com T N Goel, Com D D Maheshwari, Com R L Rao and Com N K Pareek also addressed the gathering and enthused the participating comrades. Com D Krishna Kumar, Com M S Mohan Rao, Com K S Ramachandra Rao and Com K M Shastri senior functionaries of SBI Pensioners Associations also participated. Com.Mohan Shanware, General Secretary, FORBE sent his good wishes for Dharna and conveyed about his participation in Mumbai Dharna.
