Respected Sir,

Sub: Submission of Life certificate/Declaration of marital status etc by the Pensioners/Family Pensioners within November every year.

Our organization by its letter to your goodself dated 13.09.20 requested to advise the Banks for extension of the time limit for submission of such certificates upto 31st December,2020 due to on - going pandemic Covid--19.We noted with pleasure that different Banks have started issuing Circulars in the desired direction and it would immensely benefit the older citizens.

We have come across a Circular issued by RBI on 25.09.20 wherein two instructions have been given:

- 1.) To extend the time limit for submission of such certificates within 31st December,2020 and
- 2.) to allow Pensioners to send scanned copies of such documents in prescribed format through email to the authorities concerned.

In view of the above development, we request you to advise Banks for extension of similar facilities as told in point no 2 to the Pensioners of the Industry .As physical movement of older citizens is largely restricted , the provision of such online submission would be beneficial from the point of view of their vulnerability before the dreadful disease.
