Sub: Campaign against Privatisation of Banks.

Reference may please be made to our previous circular no 86--21 dated 17th November, 21 wherein We have detailed out the programmes of UFBU which include, inter alia, Dharna in all states between 29th November 21 and 4th December 21 depending upon local convenience and Dharna before the Parliament on a date to be finalized.

Government has already listed the amendment --bills of the two relevant Acts as agenda items of the winter session of Parliament to pave the way for privatisation of Banks. Privatisation is no longer an invisible threat; it is now a visible reality. Our organization since inception has been a vociferous campaigner against Privatisation of Banks and the older citizens of the industry cannot remain silent on-looker at the moment of crisis.

We call upon all our State Committees and also our leaders stationed at different parts of the country to remain in close contact with the State level leaders of UFBU and to join the protest demonstration/assembly which are supposed to be organised on the above quoted dates. As per information available with us, Our Delhi State unit will join the rally/protest demonstration proposed to be held before the Parliament. Information also came to us that certain State Committees are taking up independent programmes on different demands of the organisation along with spirited campaign against Privatisation in addition to their participation in UFBU programmes.
